Technology

- compact, drop-shaped light metal design with two desks
- equipped with state-of-the-art security technology

As a gate to the world, Frankfurt Airport is the location in Germany where several million persons from all over the world enter the European Union. The border and passport controls are the responsibility of the Federal Republic of Germany and are conducted by the Federal Police. Fraport cooperates closely with the Federal Police to ensure quick and efficient processes in the terminals. Consequently, the airport operator assisted in implementing the new concept for the passport control booths in the terminals.

There were several reasons for this new development. The previous booths were no longer state-of-the-art in regard to design and ergonomics. The new design features light metals, saves space and can be easily moved to another location due to small wheels on the bottom. The design is elegant and customer-friendly. It fulfills all current technical requirements. All of these features help to enhance the flow of passengers according to security requirements in the terminals with as few hindrances as possible.
