

## Indira Gandhi International Airport (DEL)

### Profile:

- Second-largest airport in India
- More than 23 million passengers in 2007
- 432,000 metric tons of airfreight in 2007
- Between 10 and 15 percent growth forecast for the coming years
- Main carrier: Indian Airlines
- Hub for a large number of Indian carriers, including Air Sahara, SpiceJet, Alliance Air, and IndiGo Airlines
- Two runways and one domestic and one international passenger terminal used by 50 airlines
- Plans call for the construction of a new passenger terminal and an additional runway by 2010 to expand airport capacity to 35 million passenger per year
- Later stages of the master plan call for expanding the airport's capacity to 75 million passengers per year
