



Awards of Fraport AG

2007

- The Swiss investment bank, UBS Real Estate Kapitalanlagegesellschaft, has awarded the accolade of **Property Manager of the Year 2007** to the Fraport AG for its Property Management of the Frankfurt Airport Center (FAC 1 and FAC 2). UBS assessed 17 property management firms in Europe based on process security, letting levels and tenant satisfaction, data management, billing punctuality, internal audit assessments and reporting. Fraport AG stood out for the high quality of its work and was awarded 1st place.
- **Fraport AG** has been awarded the **audit berufundfamilie® Basic Certificate** for implementing a family-conscious employment policy. This basic certificate under the job and family audit scheme is issued by berufundfamilie GmbH, an initiative of the non-profit Hertie Foundation.

The certificate was presented in Berlin by Ursula von der Leyen, Germany's Minister for Family Affairs, Senior Citizens, Women and Youth, and Dagmar Wöhrl, Parliamentary Secretary to the German Minister of Economics and Technology Michael Glos. Both von der Leyen and Glos are the patrons of the audit scheme.

- The Hesse State Public Welfare Association (Landeswohlfahrtsverband Hessen) and the Federation of Hesse Trade Associations have honored **Fraport AG** for its **exemplary "corporate integration management"**. For many years Fraport has been dealing with the task of industrial integration management, which is designed to allow (re)integration of ill and handicapped persons into employment but at the same time attaches importance to preventive measures. Thus Fraport has been able to increase the share of severely disabled employees at the parent company from 6.5 percent in 2004 to currently 7.9 percent.
- Fraport AG was among the eight German companies having received the award "**ARBEIT PLUS 2007**" (WORK PLUS 2007) from the Association of Protestant Churches (EKD) during the German Protestant Kirchentag being held in Cologne from June 6 - 10, 2007. This award is presented to companies having created a large number of new jobs and, consequently, have made a major contribution to reducing unemployment.
- Readers of "Air Cargo World", the renowned U.S.-based international trade magazine, selected Frankfurt Airport (FRA) as the **Best European Cargo Airport**. In the category "European Airports with more than one million metric tons of freight per year" FRA was named the winner of the **Air Cargo Excellence Award**. Readers rated the airports on such criteria as quality of handling service, price-performance ratio, freight-handling infrastructure and facilities as well as efficiency of regulatory authorities at the airport.

2006

- As part of the **competition "Best IR Germany"** organized by Thomson Extel Survey and DIRK (Deutscher Investor Relations Verband), the investor relations department at Fraport AG was rewarded for its good work and achieved **3rd place among the MDAX companies**. Over 500 experts from 270 banks and fund management companies participated in the survey.
- Frankfurt (FRA) has been honored by the **Airports Council International (ACI)** as the **Best Major Airport in Europe**. Members of ACI's European region selected FRA in the category of "more than 25 million passengers per year" at the association's annual conference in Athens, Greece. Dr. Wilhelm Bender, Fraport AG's executive board chairman, accepted the award on behalf of the entire staff of the Frankfurt Airport company.
- Fraport is honored for promoting the integration of disabled persons into working life. The **City of Frankfurt's "Handicapped-friendly Business" award** went for the second time to a company in the Frankfurt/Rhine-Main region. Fraport competed for the award for the first time.
- Europe's biggest air cargo hub, Frankfurt Airport - owned and managed by Fraport AG - was named the winner of this year's **„ACE Award for Excellence“** in a reader poll of the renowned **“Air Cargo World“** trade magazine. In the category "Airports with more than one million metric tons of freight" FRA ranked clearly ahead of its European competitors Amsterdam, Paris, and London. The airports were rated on such criteria as competitiveness; service quality, e.g., in ground handling; price-performance ratio; infrastructure; safety and security; punctuality and contractual fidelity.
- At the International Tourism Fair (ITB) 2006 in Berlin Fraport AG won the **first prize of the Willy Scharnow Foundation**. Entrants in the competition were companies, institutions and persons offering innovative concepts to enhance training of persons working in the tourism business. Fraport featured its online consulting tool "ExpertNet". It offers German travel agencies the possibility to access updated and extensive information on FRA via the computer thus enabling more extensive answers to customer inquiries. All German travel agencies can use "ExpertNet" free of charge.

2005

- Frankfurt Airport (FRA) has once again been chosen as the world's **"Cargo Airport of the year 2005"** by **"Air Cargo News"**, the renowned international trade publication. This is the second year in a row that CargoCity Frankfurt (the name of FRA's airfreight areas) has received the prestigious "Cargo Airport of the year" award. Serving the global airfreight community, *Air Cargo News* is based in the U.K. and has a total of 100,000 readers on every continent.

- At its recent annual meeting, the European section of the **Airports Council International (ACI)** airport association for the first time has honored some of its members for extraordinary performance. In the "major airports" category, Frankfurt Airport won the **ACI Europe Best Airport Award** in recognition of its outstanding performance in terms of environmental management aimed at sustainability.

2004

- The journal "**Air Cargo News**", which is published in London, voted CargoCity Frankfurt to "**Cargo Airport of the year**". Consequently, this was a double honor in that Frankfurt was designated as the best Cargo airport worldwide and for the third time as no. 1 of all hub airports in Europe. The jury was convinced by the multitude of services offered in CargoCity Frankfurt, the magnitude of scheduled cargo flights and seamless connections to other modes of transportation.
 - **Lufthansa** presented to Fraport's Aviation Ground Services & Logistics division the "**Station Award 2003**" for best implementation of an aircraft handling concept. The award, which covers various aspects of ground handling, was presented for the first time.

- Fraport AG's new image video, titled "Frankfurt Airport Services Worldwide - A Portrait of an Airport Group", received an award at the International Tourism Exchange (ITB) in Berlin. The video **ranked second in the business category of the "Goldene Stadtor 2003" (Golden City Gate 2003) city film contest**. A jury consisting of tourism and film experts watched and rated over 80 videos submitted for the contest. The contest was organized by the Federation of Film Services of the German states (Konferenz der Landesfilmdienste, Bonn/Berlin) in cooperation with the German Association of Film and AV Producers. - **Business Traveller Award:** Readers of Germany's "Business Traveller" magazine have voted Frankfurt Airport as the "**Best Airport in Europe**" overall. Over 3,000 frequent flyers, readers surveyed by the Munich-based business travel publication, gave top marks to FRA. Amsterdam Schiphol Airport ranked second, followed by Zurich Airport. In the international comparison, FRA climbed three positions to take the third ranking. This is the latest of many Business Traveller awards won over the years by Fraport AG Frankfurt Airport Services Worldwide, the company that owns and manages FRA.
- **AirCargo News:** Frankfurt Airport has been named **Europe's most efficient and important air cargo hub** by the U.K.-based "**Air Cargo News**". This is the first time that the bi-weekly trade publication has prepared such a ranking. Decisive factors in the jury's choice were Frankfurt Airport's facilities for handling and storing cargo goods of all types and sizes, its versatile daily flight

schedule, its critical mass of cargo services and its excellent links to rail and road networks. Along with FRA in Europe, Hong Kong was chosen the best air cargo hub in Asia, Dubai in the Middle East and Calgary in North America. With about 100,000 readers worldwide, AirCargo News calls itself the leading trade publication of the international airfreight industry.

- **"Manager Magazin"**, one of Germany's leading business publications, has honored Fraport AG in its "best annual report" competition held in Frankfurt. Fraport AG's **2001 Annual Report received second prize in the "newly listed stock companies" category**. Fraport AG was successfully listed on the stock exchange in June 2001. In September 2001, Fraport already became a member of the MDAX, the German mid cap index of Deutsche Börse AG.

2001

- At the prestigious **Asian Freight Industry Awards 2001** Frankfurt Airport received two awards: **"Best Airport - Europe"** and **"Best Air Cargo Terminal Operator - Europe"**. Frankfurt Airport has won the "Best Airport-Europe" award four times in the past five years: from 1997 to 1999, and now in 2001. In 1998, FRA also picked up the "Best Air Cargo Terminal Operator - Europe" award. The AFIA awards are organized by the Hong Kong-based publication Cargonews Asia, which polls 13,000 senior freight industry professionals throughout Asia to select the best companies in 37 categories in major trading areas worldwide. FRA is highly regarded because of its strategic location in the heart of the "new" Europe, excellent transportation links, efficient and fast ground handling, intensified customer orientation, as well as heavy investments in airport infrastructure such as the Fraport-Cargo Terminal and intermodal air/rail links for the CargoCity South development.
- **Business Traveller Award:** Readers of the German "Business Traveller" magazine have once again selected Frankfurt Airport as the **"Best Airport in Germany"**. This year's awards are based on responses from about 3,500 readers of the Munich-based business travel publication. In the European comparison, Frankfurt Airport took first place again, followed by Amsterdam Schiphol Airport. In the international comparison, frequent flyers ranked FRA among the top 10 airports in the world. FRA placed number six after Singapore, Chicago, Hong Kong, Dubai and Atlanta airports and ahead of New York, Amsterdam, London and Paris airports.

2000

- **Business Traveller Award**
Once again, Germany's frequent fliers have awarded Frankfurt Airport top marks: in a survey, some 2,000 readers of "Business Traveller" magazine, published in Hamburg, rated Frankfurt as **the best German airport** with a clear lead over Munich. In an European comparison readers once again placed FRA first ahead of Amsterdam and Zurich, too. Internationally the survey showed that Frankfurt ranks high for many frequent fliers, and is surpassed only by Singapore, Chicago and Hong Kong, too.
