

1. Requirements for Requesting Airport ID Cards

What are the requirements for being entitled to request an Airport ID Card?





2. License Agreement with Fraport AG's Retail Department

Why is a license agreement needed?	Who is required to have a license?	Validity of license and costs
 Without a valid license, providers cannot request Airport ID Cards 	 All providers that are hired by tenants of Retail and Properties (HVM-R) 	 The license is concluded for the term of activity, for a maximum of two years
 Under German aviation security laws (LuftSig and LuftVZO) and EU security requirements: → access and entry to landside and airside areas for authorized persons only 	 Architects, tradespeople, suppliers, etc. Note: All subcontractors require their own license – signed by the tenant. 	 If the activity will last longer than two years, the license must be renewed in good time No charge



3. ID Colors – What Do They Mean?

3. Short-Term ID Cards – No License Agreement Needed

3. Short-Term ID Cards – No License Agreement Needed

Short-Term ID Cards for nighttime work in security restricted area (1 night per month / with accompanying person)

- → Short-Term IDs issued after 5:00 p.m. can be issued on request until 11:59 p.m. of the next day.
- → Short-Term IDs can be ordered and picked up from the SCF, or at the Short-Term ID office in Terminal 1, or at airport access gate Tor 3a



3. Background Check, Aviation Security + Safety Management Training

Background Check

- → Everyone requesting a blue or yellow ID must go through a background check
- → Background check is conducted by the Frankfurt Police Department
- → Background check takes up to six weeks
- → ID application (part B) automatically includes performance of the background check
- → Validity: 5 years
- → Background check acknowledged nationwide

Note:

- → If the background check was initiated by Fraport AG for the original ID application, a new check will automatically be arranged by Fraport (in case of a requested ID renewal)
- If the background check was requested in another German state or directly from the Frankfurt Police Department, you must arrange for the renewal yourself. <u>Note:</u> Fraport will not send a reminder.
 - → Even if the ID card is still valid, it will be frozen upon expiration of the background check



3. Background Check, Aviation Security + Safety Management Training

Aviation Security Training

- → Can be done online
- → Every entitled person will receive a personal access code after submitting the ID application to the SCF; it will be sent by post to the company
- → Validity: 5 years
- → Takes about 3 hours

Safety Management Training (SMS)

- → Everyone requesting a yellow ID must complete basic online safety training and pass a test
- → After a request (by post) the training must be completed within eight weeks
- → Training is valid for five years
- → Well in advance of expiration of the training, you will be automatically reminded to complete it again







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4. Completing a License Agreement – Common Errors

Link to the license form

Incomplete company name	 Company name + company address must match the information in commercial register or business registration
Incomplete address information	Company domicile (complete address incl. e-mail)
Missing signature of requesting party	 Requesting party is the intent – for all subcontractors as well
Missing attachments	 Current CR excerpt or copy of business registration Missing documentation of liability insurance
Errors in documentation of liability insurance	 Coverage amount is too low Invalid term of liability insurance Company name or address does not match information in the license agreement

Step **0** – Company registration

- → Via web portal:
 - ↔ Enter all contract and general company data
 - → Generate and print out the PDF file
 - → Get signatures from those persons who are entitled to sign ID card applications and/or an authorized agent
 - Scan and send via e-mail to flughafenausweise@fraport.de
 - After processing by the SCF, you receive an e-mail with the access information for the web portal
- Via PDF company info sheet
 - ↔ Scan and send via e-mail to flughafenausweise@fraport.de



Step *2* – Request a personal Airport ID Card

- → Applications are processed only if filled out digitally
- Print out the completed application, sign it (applicant and authorized signatory), scan and send in PDF format including attachments to <u>flughafenausweise@fraport.de</u>

Attachments to ID application:

- To reduce the number of rejected applications due to incorrect data, please attach a passport copy
- The review and serial number on the passport copy should be blacked out by the applicant
- The data from the passport copy will be used only for data comparison upon initial review of the application, and then destroyed immediately afterward
- Part B Background check and criminal records check:
- All residences and employment for the last five years must be filled out; no gaps
- If residence in the last five years, longer than six months, is in a foreign country:
 Criminal records check / European certificate of good conduct must be attached (Embassy)
 - Document must be submitted with a certified German translation
 - English certificates do not need translation



Step *2* – Request a personal Airport ID Card

Part C - Company-related data from the applicant company

Name and signature of the authorized signatory who is also listed on the company info sheet under "Authorized signatory of the applicant company"

Part D: Requesting party for work at Frankfurt Airport

> Does not need to be filled out, license agreement replaces signature

Step **9** – Pick up Airport ID Card

- → The SCF will send an e-mail when the ID is ready for personal pickup
- ↔ You must bring a valid national ID card or passport to pick it up
- → Non-EU citizens must also bring their residence permits

Step *O* – Request a Vehicle ID Card

- → Once the Vehicle ID Card is ready, our SCF will send a pickup notice.
- → For pickup, please make an appointment at www.fraport.com → Business & Partner →
 Services → Airport ID Cards → Arranging a Pickup Date
- There is an additional charge for direct application processing at the Airport ID Card Service Center.
- *Original vehicle registration certificate* must be brought to the SCF.
- → Vehicle ID Cards do not include parking permits, parking spaces must be leased separately.
- The term depends on the term of activity or expiration date of the most recent general vehicle inspection.



Step G – **Application for code to enter the basement road**

- + The underground levels of Terminals 1 and 2 contain the basement roads used for delivery
- Access is via airport access gate Tor 3 after proper access control
- To enter the basement road in Terminal 1 via access gate Tor11a you need a special code

→ Documents required:

- completed "Application to issue a code to drive onto the basement road, Terminal 1" with signature of the tenant (Item 7)
- Copy of vehicle registration
- Copy of driver's license
- You can receive the application for a code from Reinhard Goertz, (r.goertz@fraport.de) or Eric Schreiner (e.schreiner@fraport.de). Please also send the completed application to both e-mail addresses.
- → If no permanent access is needed to the basement road, you can have a one-day pass issued at airport access gate Tor 3 (max. 4 x 14 days a year)



Step *O* – Returning Airport ID Cards
