Fact sheet on the lounges of the Frankfurt Airport VIP-Services

As of summer, 2023, Frankfurt Airport VIP-Services will be operating out of two separate lounges:

- VIP-Transitlounge and
- VIP-Terminal

With its landside location, the VIP-Terminal is ideal for hosting arriving and departing passengers, while the VIP-Transitlounge will continue its services for transferring passengers.

Art

The lounges are decorated with art from various centuries: works by artists ranging from Johann Jakob Hoch, Giovanni Battista Piranesi, Christiane Baumgartner, Gideon Rubin to Alex Katz and Jakob Mattner; drawings, etchings, lithographs, graphics, and oil paintings of the 18th and 20th centuries; and 19th century Japanese ink drawings.

VIP fleet

The VIP fleet features mainly German premium and luxury brands (Audi, Mercedes, and BMW) as well as selected international luxury brands, such as Bentley. As of summer 2023, the VIP fleet will offer a total of 22 vehicles. Guests' preferences for certain vehicles are gladly taken into account.
